### **MATTERS ARISING**

This paper deals with points not covered by substantive items on the agenda. The numbers relate to the minutes of the September meeting.

#### **3. Fourth Quinquennial Review of Schedules 5 and 8 of The Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981: Recommendations from the Working Group**

- i. At the June 2002 Joint Committee meeting it was explained that, following an instance of wholesale collecting of scarce subspecies of Burnet moth in Scotland, further consideration was being given to whether one or more subspecies of these moths should be included on Schedule 5. Following the investigation of the case referred to, the Quinquennial Review Working Group recommended that two subspecies of Burnet moth be added to Schedule 5 and afforded full protection under Section 9 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act. The Joint Committee was consulted by post and it was agreed to incorporate these recommendations in the submission to the Secretary of State.
