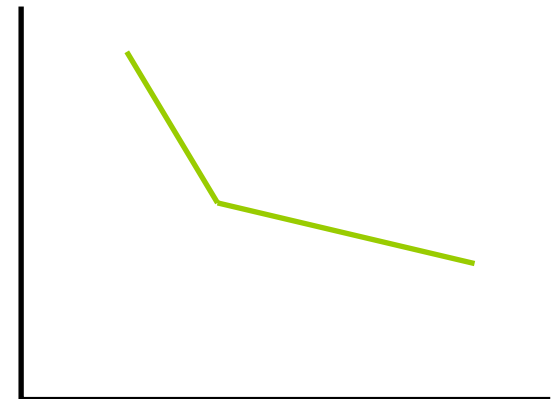

- resource transfers, both ODA and technology

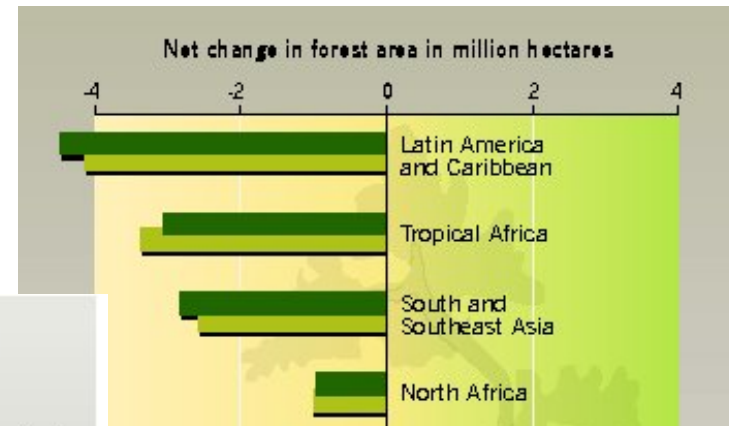
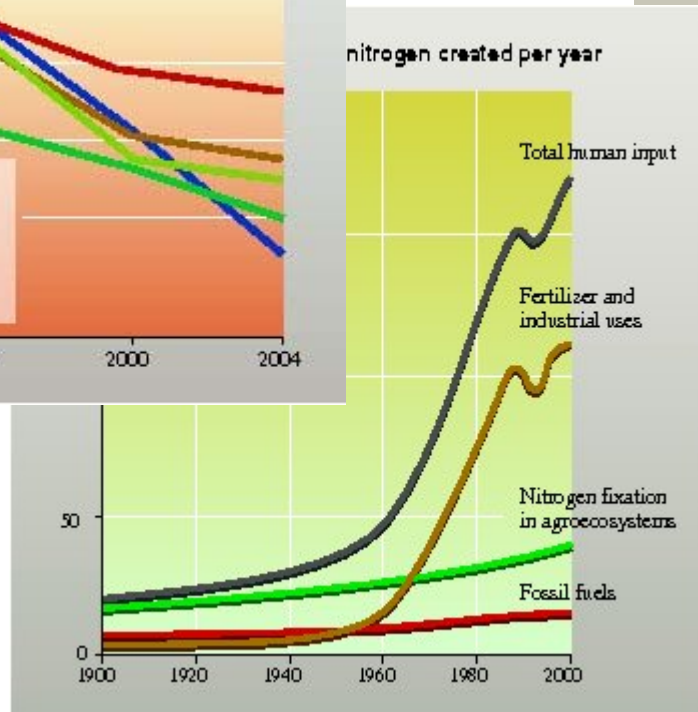
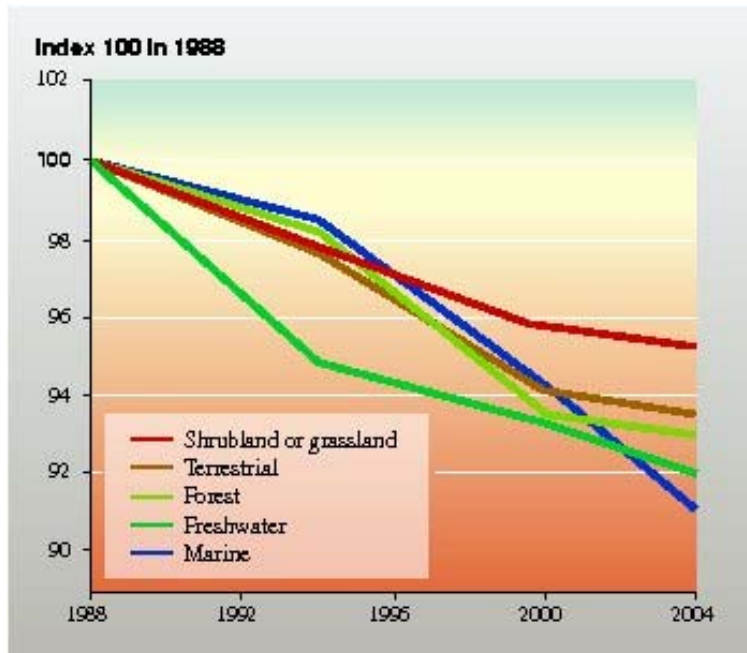

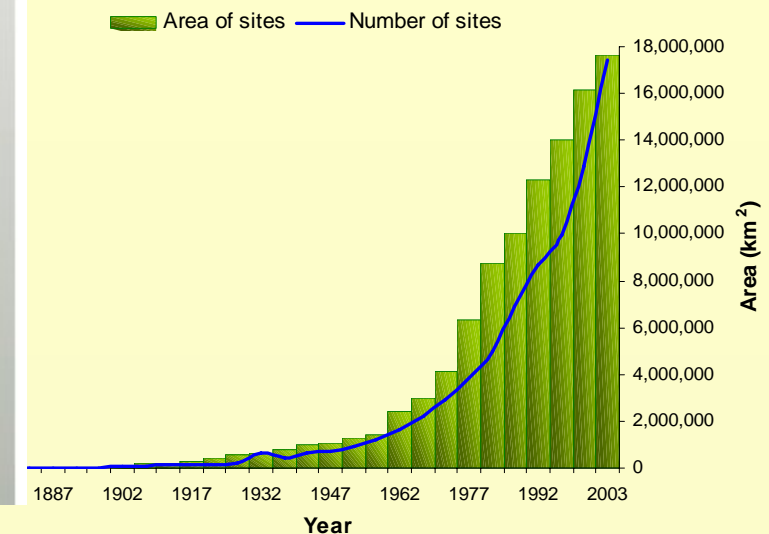

Linking global, regional, and national indicators


- Global indicators often applicable at regional and national levels – data can be disaggregated, and methodologies transferred between scales.
- Regional and national indicators often scalable to global level – through the aggregation of data.
- 2010BIP linkages with national and regional initiatives, such as in Europe, Arctic, Latin America, etc...

Linkages with MDGs


- Proposal to adopt 2010 target as new target within MDG7 at UN General Assembly in Sep 2006 – currently under discussion.
 - Indicators yet to be proposed, focussing on:
 - Composition of biodiversity: habitats, species, genetic resources, protected areas
 - Sustainability (forest management, fish stocks)
 - Ecosystem integrity (Marine Trophic Index, water quality, habitat fragmentation)

 - Important to determine user needs – to advise 2010BIP outputs and communication strategy.

 - Aug 06: Funding approval by GEF (\$3.6m)
 - Dec 06 - Dec 09: Implementation of full project, development of indicators and reporting to 2010 target.
 - 2009 – 2012: Second phase, establishing ongoing indicator development and reporting
