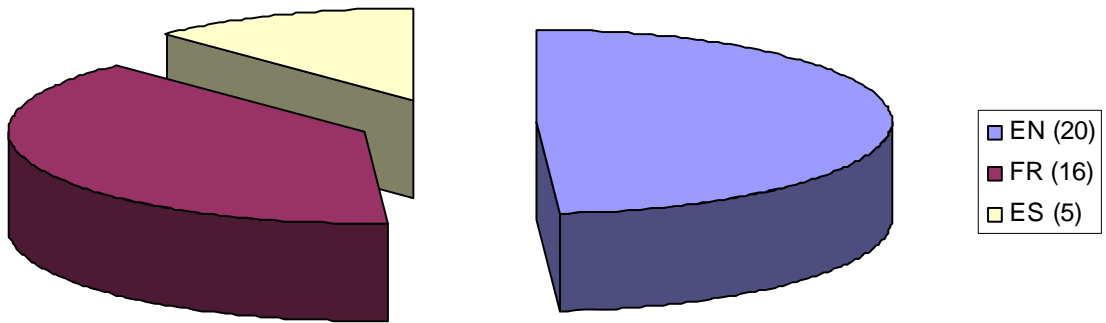

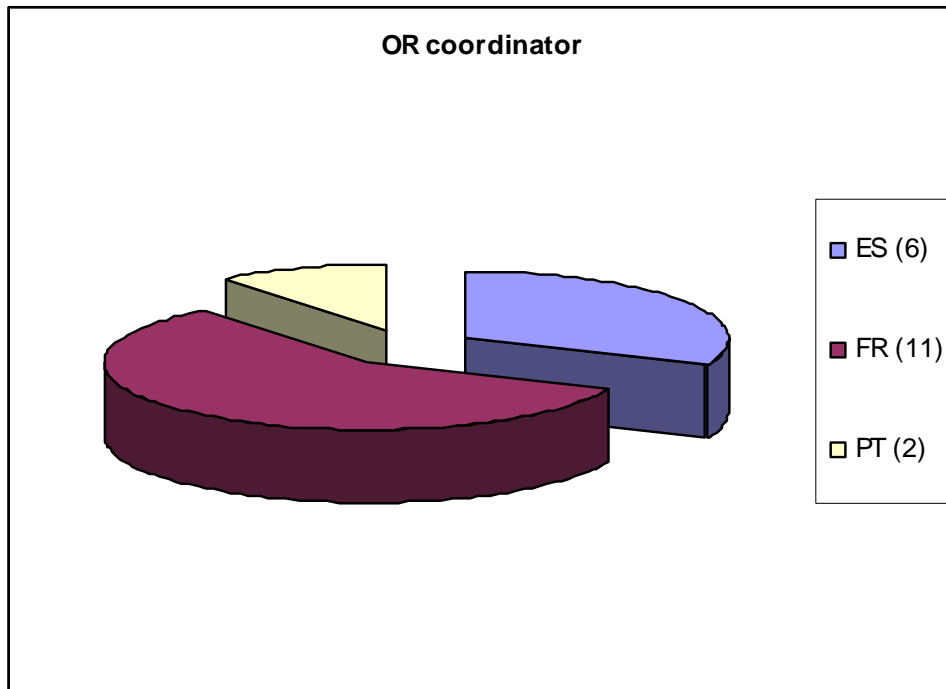


Number of partners per proposal





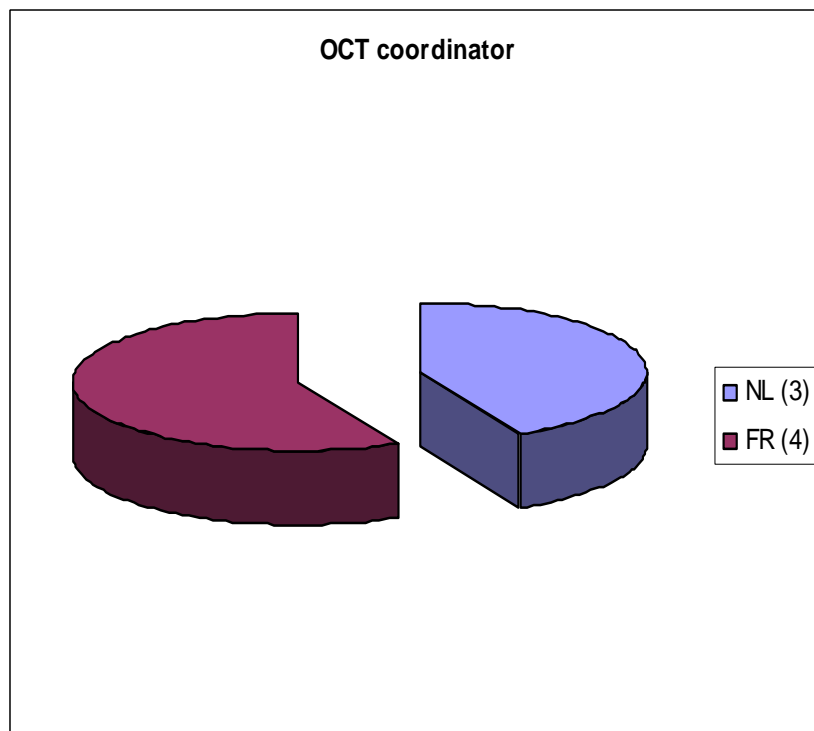

PT: 2 proposals from Madeira;

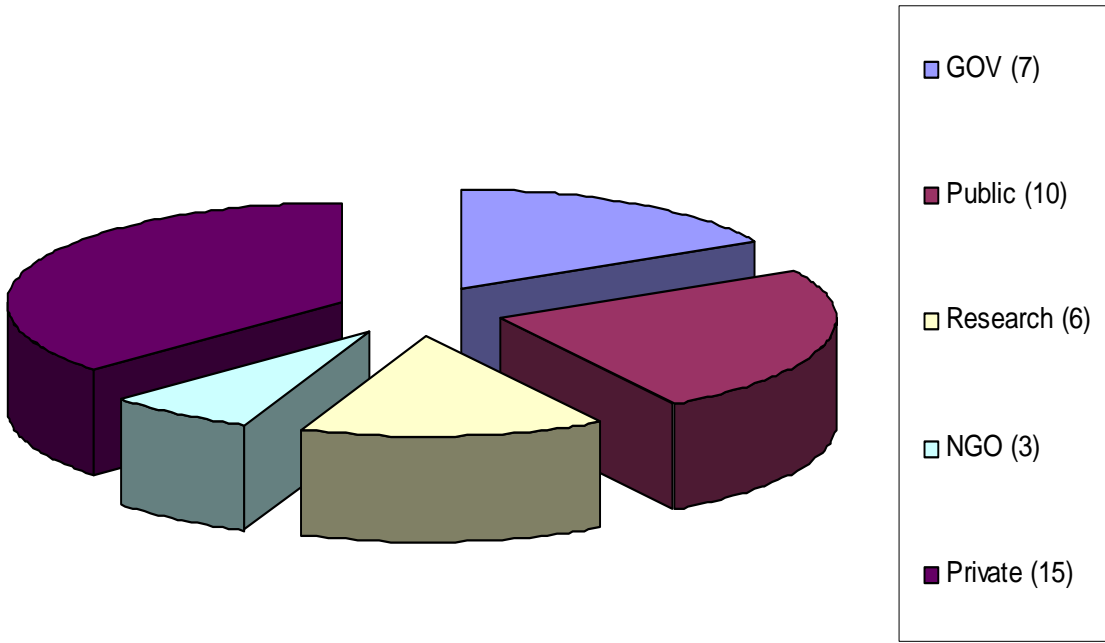
FR: 5 proposals from Guiana, 2 from Guadeloupe, 1 from Martinique (included 11 actions!), 3 from La Reunion



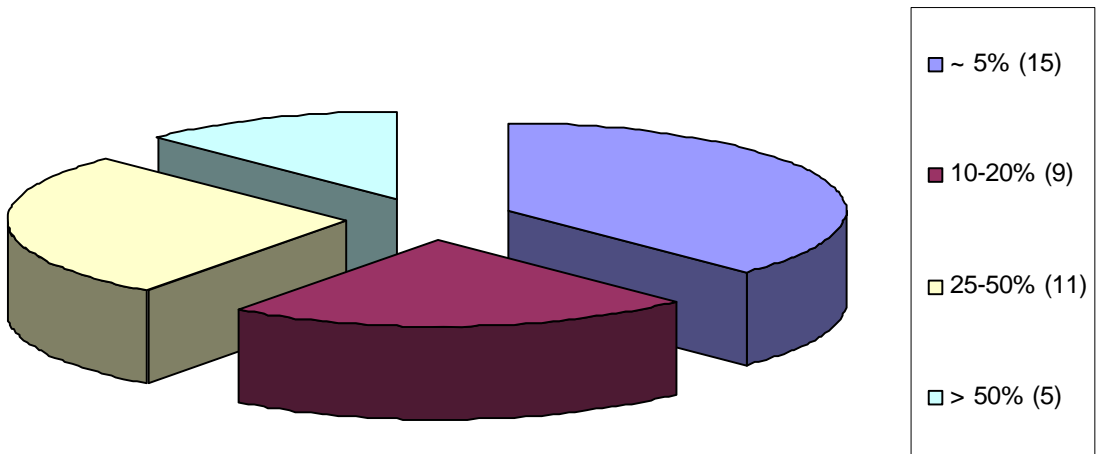
NL: 1 proposal from Curaçao, 1 from Bonaire and 1 from St Eustatius

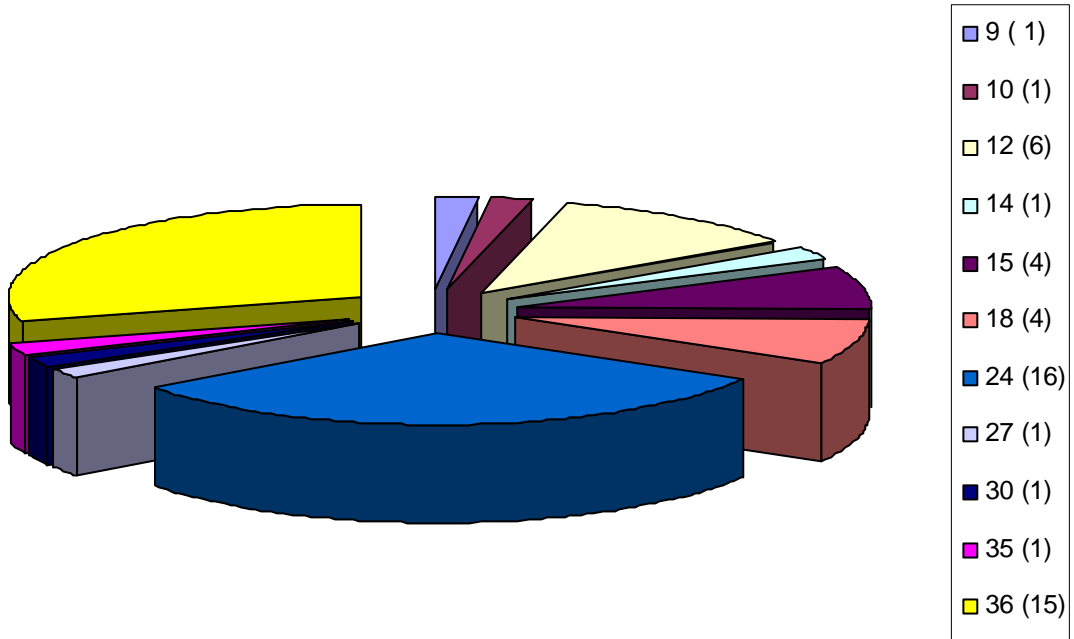
